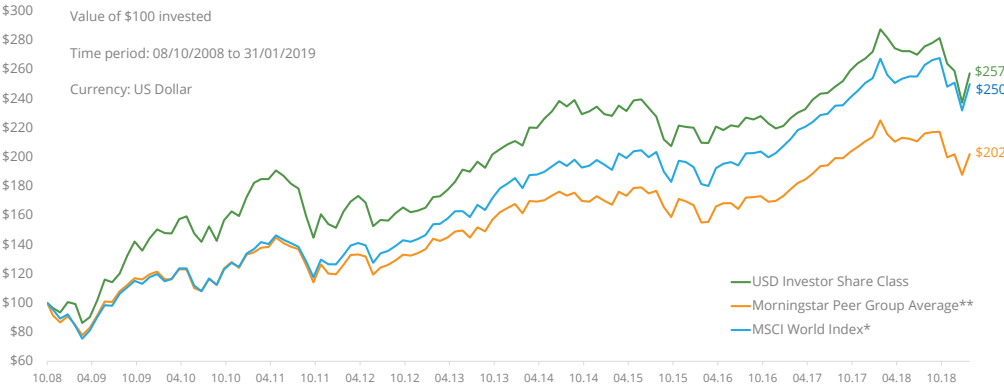

The Fund is a global long only equity fund. The investment objective is to outperform the MSCI World Index* and to provide capital growth over a medium to long-term time horizon.

COMMENTARY

World markets roared back to life in January with the MSCI World Index returning +7.8%. Your fund returned +8.4% in the month with the 3 largest contributors to performance being: Celgene, Citigroup and Quanta Services. Celgene received a takeover bid from Bristol Myers, which contributed to the out-performance, and better than expected results from a number of our Financial sector holdings, including Citigroup and Goldman Sachs, led to these shares rallying. The level of fear late last year was so great that both Citigroup and Goldman Sachs were trading at less than 8x earnings and below the value of their net tangible assets, valuations normally reserved for businesses in extreme distress. But in sharp contrast to this fear, Citi's financial strength allowed it to re-purchase 8% of its shares over the year and together with improved operating efficiency and a lower tax rate, increase earnings per share by 25% for the full year. Indeed, its CEO, Mike Corbat, commented on the earnings call that, "economic growth is stronger and more resilient than recent market volatility would indicate." Furthermore, the company is targeting to increase its efficiency and Return on Equity even further this year. Like many industries today, Banks certainly have their challenges, but technology is helping them to cut costs (for example banking apps replacing high cost branch infrastructure) and divisions such as loans and credit cards provide attractive annuity income. By way of comparison, Consumer Staples are considered to be far higher "quality" companies than banks, but they too face substantial challenges such as: regulation (tobacco & sugary soft drinks), retailers promoting their own higher margin private label brands, and large TV advertising budgets no longer providing a barrier to entry from upstarts who launch their products on YouTube. Yet the likes of Procter & Gamble, Coke and Colgate Palmolive are all priced at over 20x forward earnings for low single digit eps growth at best. Faced with these growth challenges, many companies in this sector have resorted to debt funded acquisitions at low interest rates. In October 2016, the global brewer Anheuser-Busch paid \$114bn for SAB Miller before being forced by competition authorities to divest many of their joint venture holdings at low prices. Today, ABI has 21% more shares in issue, \$60bn more in net debt and earnings per share this year is expected to be 25% below that earned in 2015. Yet the company still trades on 20x 2018 earnings, without including the debt. Since we believe banks offer higher earnings per share growth for less than half the price of many Consumer Staples is the reason your fund has a higher weighting in the Financials sector than the Consumer Staples sector.

Share class information

- (1) Includes a period when the fund was incorporated in Jersey between 26/8/08 and 29/09/11.
- (2) The USD Advisor class carries an additional 0.5% p.a fee which is paid to the financial intermediary.
- (3) The Ranmore Global Equity Fund GBP and EUR classes are not currency hedged classes. The difference between the returns in these classes and the USD class is due only to changes in the GBP/USD and EUR/USD exchange rates over the measurement period
- (4) The ongoing charges figure (OCF) has been calculated based on operating expenses of the Fund for the 12 month period ended 31/12/18 as a percentage of average Fund net assets of \$105m over the same period. The OCF includes all fund operating expenses for the USD, GBP and EUR investor classes, but excludes the 0.5% payable to the financial intermediary for the USD Advisor class. The OCF does not include transaction costs.

Fund details

The Fund's benchmark is the MSCI World Index, which is a broad global equity benchmark that represents large and mid-cap equity performance across 23 developed markets countries. It covers approximately 85% of the free float-adjusted market capitalization in each country and does not offer exposure to emerging markets.

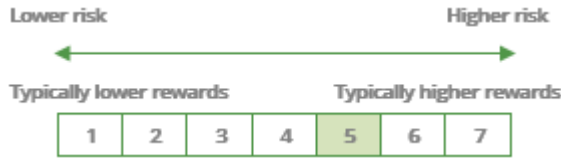
Highest & Lowest return: The highest and lowest returns for any 1 year over the period since inception have been shown.
