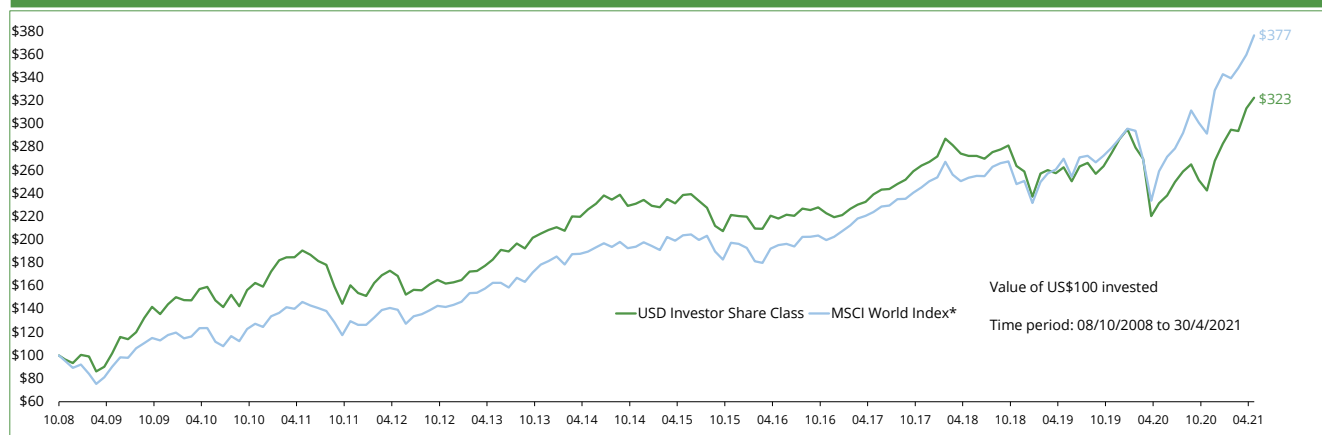

COMMENTARY

At their peaks, Yahoo was valued at \$100bn and America on Line (AOL) was valued at \$200bn. Last week, they were collectively bought for \$5bn by private equity company, Apollo. That's wealth destruction of 98%. How on earth did two of the companies that brought us the internet we all use today get to be worth so little? Well, things change. Read AOL's 2000 Annual Report and you'll notice 43% revenue growth, a tripling of profits, cash flow, subscriber growth, advertising growth, a subscription business model. You'll calculate a 25% return on equity, applaud the company's visionary management and conclude it's "capital light". In short, it has all the characteristics, and used most of the buzzwords, that analysts love today. But, unfortunately, both existed in the fast-changing technology sector where it's often forgotten that a "10,000 lb gorilla" is also not immune to being mortally wounded by tiny scorpions.

What was the problem? People overpaid, and when things change, capital light also means no margin of safety.

No value investors worthy of the title would have owned these companies at the highs and I'm sure for a few years, like us, they would have looked stupid not dancing at that party.

Thankfully, like years, parties end and new parties begin and we're quite enjoying this one.

We think most people are value investors at heart – who doesn't want their money to go further? And anyone who looks beyond historic performance and "under the hood" will understand that value investing just makes sound financial sense.

COMMENTARY

As an example, the pandemic has led to people spending more money on their houses. They are no longer just homes; for many they're now: our offices, our gyms, our restaurants and our cinemas. If you don't have to pay to commute to work each day, you have more disposable income to spend on a larger house. Pretend we're like the aforementioned Apollo, an astute private equity investor who knows the value of money. We have a choice today of buying:

Zillow, the "leading online real estate marketplace company" for \$29bn. It generated \$50m of net income last year off \$3.5bn of annual sales that only grew 8% in the latest quarter.

Or

We can buy the 3rd largest homebuilder in the US for \$16bn (half the price), but which generated 30x the net income (\$1.5bn), even more free cash flow AND grew revenue more than twice as fast: 19% last quarter. Plus, Pulte has a landbank, the value of which is rising with property prices, and it is buying back shares, not dishing out more to employees.

At current multiples, with Pulte you get your money back in 10 years. With Zillow, who knows? We know for sure Google and Amazon aren't about to build houses, but one day they may try to sell them.

So, for us, it's Pulte on every metric – but if you're "buying historic performance", you'd buy Zillow because it went up 184% last year, which was 14 times more than Pulte's 13% rise.

So what are you doing: buying historic performance or what makes sense?

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Ranmore Global Equity Fund Plc has been authorised by the Central Bank of Ireland as an open-ended investment company registered by way of continuation in Ireland pursuant to the UCITS Regulations 2011. The Fund is a global long-only equity fund.

The investment objective is to outperform the MSCI World Index* and to provide capital growth over a medium to long-term time horizon.

Fund details

The Fund's benchmark is the MSCI World Index, which is a broad global equity benchmark that represents large and mid-cap equity performance across 23 developed markets countries. It covers approximately 85% of the free float-adjusted market capitalization in each country and does not offer exposure to emerging markets.

Share class information

- (1) Includes a period when the fund was incorporated in Jersey between 26/8/08 and 29/09/11.
- (2) The USD Advisor class carries an additional 0.5% p.a fee which is paid to the financial intermediary.
- (3) The Ranmore Global Equity Fund GBP and EUR classes are not currency hedged classes. The difference between the returns in these classes and the USD class is due only to changes in the GBP/USD and EUR/USD exchange rates over the measurement period
- (4) The ongoing charges figure (OCF) of 1.36% has been calculated based on operating expenses of the Fund for the 12 month period ended 31/12/20 as a percentage of average Fund net assets of \$82m over the same period. The OCF includes all fund operating expenses for the USD, GBP and EUR investor classes, but excludes the 0.5% payable to the financial intermediary for the USD Advisor class. The OCF does not include transaction costs.

Forward pricing is used.

The Total Expense Ratio (TER) is a measure of how much of the Fund's assets are relinquished as payments for services rendered in the administration of the Fund. Transaction Costs are a measure of the costs incurred in buying and selling the underlying assets of the Fund. Both the TER and TC are expressed as a percentage of the daily NAV of the Fund calculated over a period of three years on an annualised basis.

Glossary of terms

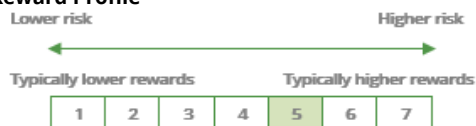
Annualised performance: Annualised performance show longer term performance rescaled to a 1 year period. Annualised performance is the average return per year over the period. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request.

Highest & Lowest return: The highest and lowest returns for any 1 year over the period since inception have been shown.

NAV: The net asset value represents the assets of a Fund less its liabilities.
