COMMENTARY

Investors rushed to anything AI related during the month as Nvidia forecast that the world's data centre infrastructure would need a \$1trillion "re-tooling" to cope with AI. Tech investors cheered and drove the market cap of the Nasdaq \$1.2trillion higher.

Since the major constituents of the Nasdaq will bear the majority of this "re-tooling" cost and since Microsoft, Alphabet and Apple "only" spent a combined \$64bn in capex over the past year, either their capex bills are about to rise exponentially, or this forecast is wrong. Either way, we think it's bad news for investors paying the current high prices for these companies.

Our top contributor to performance in the month was our largest position, Petrobras (PBR), which rose 8% (had you bought PBR a few days earlier on 27th April, you would have received an additional quarterly dividend equal to a further 5.5%). This is in sharp contrast to industry peers such as Exxon Mobil, which fell 13% as the WTI oil price declined from \$77 to \$68. So how did Petrobras rise when industry peers fell? We think the answer lies in Petrobras' very low valuation. By way of illustration, PBR earned \$7.9bn of free cash flow in Q1, whereas Exxon earned \$11.8bn (50% more). But Exxon's enterprise value of \$497bn was nearly 7 times greater than Petrobras' \$74bn, not 50% more!

Many investors don't like Petrobras because they are concerned about political risk given the Brazilian government's socialist tendencies. But political risk is a factor in almost all large multi-nationals, including technology companies. 63% of Exxon's revenue is earned outside the USA and on 18th April Exxon declared "Force Majeure" on Nigerian production. In contrast, the Lula Government has been in power for five months and has yet to take hostile action towards shareholders. In fact, the Brazilian Government's interests and those of third-party shareholders should be closely aligned: Petrobras is the largest tax-payer in Brazil, one of the largest employers and the Brazilian Government controls it with 50.26%. At less than 4 times earnings, we think Petrobras is discounting fairly significant risks.

Contrast that with Nvidia trading at 37 times sales. Even if Nvidia were to double sales and then earned 50% net margins (above the highest ever of 38%) the company would still be on over 40 times earnings.

Petrobras generated 50% more free cash flow in Q1 than Nvidia has earned over the last year and yet Nvidia's market cap is 12x larger than PBR's. Hopefully this stark difference in valuations helps explain why we own Petrobras and not Nvidia.

Ongoing Charges Figure (OCF)

UCITS funds are required to calculate an OCF. It is a measure of the costs of operating the Fund. It is calculated in accordance with a methodology published by European regulators. The OCF of the Fund was 1.47%, calculated based on operating expenses of the Fund for the 12 month period ended 31/12/22 as a percentage of average Fund net assets of \$67.7m over the same period. The OCF includes all fund operating expenses for the USD, GBP and EUR investor classes, but excludes the 0.5% payable to the financial intermediary for the USD Advisor class.

The OCF figure is not applicable to the USD Institutional class. The Investment Manager has agreed with the Fund to rebate a portion, or all, of the Investment Management Fee attributable to the USD Institutional Class in order to facilitate the capping of the Capped Fees incurred by Shareholders in USD Institutional Class at an annualised 1.00%, subject to certain limitations. Please refer to the prospectus of the Fund for further details.

The OCF methodology does not include broker commissions, which were an additional 0.22% over the aforementioned period.

Fund details

The Fund's benchmark is the MSCI World Index, a broad global equity benchmark that represents large and mid-cap equity performance across 23 developed markets. It covers approximately 85% of the free float-adjusted market cap in each country and does not offer exposure to emerging markets.

Share class information

The USD Advisor class carries an additional 0.5% p.a fee which is paid to the financial intermediary.

The Ranmore Global Equity Fund GBP and EUR classes are not currency hedged classes. The difference between the returns in these classes and the USD class is due only to changes in the GBP/USD and EUR/USD exchange rates over the measurement period.

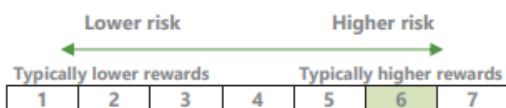
Glossary of terms
